525 WEST 52ND STREET — NEW YORK CITY, USA

Upon walking through the grand, double-height entrance, residents of 525 West 52nd Street pass under Rachel Mica Weiss' 'Inverted Arches.' Commissioned by Art Assets, the twenty-foot entrance piece, made of nylon rope, creates striking silhouettes and intricate, dramatic shadows that change throughout the day. This luxury two-tower development in Hell's Kitchen, developed by Taconic Investment Partners and Mitsui Fudosan America, uses industrial materials and handcrafted techniques that seamlessly integrate art and architecture, highlighting the history of the industrial neighbourhood and reflecting the daily lives of residents. Here, residents can experience a variety of exclusive activities such as outdoor yoga, social events on the Rooftop Lounge, film series in the Screening Room, hosting a virtual Masters event on the Golf Simulators, and more.



a stunning double-height, floor-to-

ceiling glass art installation that was

inspired by the building's neighbour,

MoMa PS1. The Long Island City con-

dominium developer commissioned

artist Tom Fruin (who is behind the

famous Dumbo water tower) to cu-

rate a one-of-a-kind mosaic glass-art

wall in the building's entryway, giv-

ing the space a unique gallery feel.

The Jackson is a 56-unit luxury condo

with apartments ranging from studios

to three-bedroom homes, between

US\$700,000 to 4 million. Building

amenities include a social room, a chil-

dren's play room, a resident's gym, a

rooftop with private cabanas, under-

ground parking, and a ground-floor

retail component.



90 MORTON — WEST VILLAGE, NY CITY, USA

90 Morton, a 12-story boutique condominium in the West Village, features an entire gallery exhibition of eye-level floor sculptures curated by artist Danielle Gottesman, daughter of the development's concept architect, Asaf Gottesman. Developed by Brack Capital Real Estate, the building is composed by thirty-five residences, each starting at US\$5.3 million. The 90 Morton's amenities include 24-hour attended lobby, virtual concierge service by LIV, adjacent resident's library, cold storage room, 64' indoor pool with direct elevator access for privacy, saunas and private changing rooms with showers and individual lockers, ground floor fitness centre with large windows for natural light, children's playroom, and a common rooftop with a full outdoor kitchen, BBQ, powder room, and outdoor gas fire place.


